



## **Annex 7) Access Regulation for Vienna Nußdorf**

Access regulations for the feeder traffic to the ship berths in Nußdorf

### **1. Time regulation**

“Slots” apply to all four ship berths. During peak hours in the morning, the berths may only be approached by buses at certain times:

Bus standing time:

Company <b>Lüftner</b>	8:00 a.m., departure no later than 8:15 a.m.
Company <b>Litschauer</b> (DSGL)	8:30 a.m., departure no later than 8:45 a.m.
<b>Donau Schiffsstationen GmbH</b> (Dst 29 & 34)	9:00 a.m., departure no later than 9:15 a.m.

After all passengers have been processed for their shore excursions, access may be used by suppliers and other service providers, therefore at the earliest from 9:30/10:00 a.m.!

### **2. Buses may stop briefly to pick up/drop off guests but may not be parked for longer. Drivers may not leave the bus (no lunch breaks on the ship or similar!).**

The district administrative authority monitors this and issues penalties.

### **4. Short-term stopping at the ship berths – regulation of the City of Vienna**

Boarding and alighting for buses:

- On the bus access road → waterside and not toward the street!
- Do not endanger or block other road users!
- The turning area must be kept clear!
- No parking (see point 2)

Please note the height and weight restrictions. Access via Schemmerlbrücke (height restriction 3.80 m and weight restriction 25 t), access via Heiligenstädter Straße through an underpass (height restriction 3.40 m).

**Loading area for feeder services to the ship landing stages in Nußdorf**

Monday to Friday
10:00 – 11.30 h 14.30 – 16.30 h

On Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays, loading is only permitted from the end of September to mid-June at the times mentioned above!

Small trucks (up to 3.5 t) may drive directly to the towpath without blocking it.

In general, semi-trailers are prohibited in Nußdorf!

For a smooth process (compliance with the times, coordination of berths), the Danube station must be informed at least 24 hours in advance.

The instructions of our on-site security service must be followed!

These access regulations must be observed! In case of non-compliance, a contractual penalty of €150 will be charged!
